This year we ran two VOD contests: one for Highland Park HS and the other for Deerfield HS. First, second and third place prizes of \$500.00, \$300.00 and \$200.00, respectively, were offered at each school. Out of a combined enrollment of about 3600 students we received one entry: First place winner Sophie M. Draluck of Highland Park.

The school liaisons we work with are getting the news out about the program. Something else is going on. The Tribune and Pioneer Press recently have been running articles about illness-causing stress levels at elite schools, like HP and Deerfield. Here's a quote from the Dec 8 Tribune: "In many top-performing schools, students and experts describe an atmosphere of intense, sometimes disabling, pressure connected with test scores, college admissions and AP course loads." Is competition for college entrance so intense everything else is forced out?

We did better with the Pat Pen program, which offered the same prizes but only in one contest for participating middle school students. The winners were: First Place-David Ayzman from Elm Place Middle School; Second Place-Celestine K. Harig of Holy Cross School; and, Third Place-Hailey R.
